Policy on Identification, Monitoring and Conservation IUCN and Other Species

This policy focuses on the identification, monitoring, and preservation of IUCN-listed and other species that inhabit areas impacted by Ege University's (EU) activities. By implementing this policy, EU seeks to play a more active role in shaping and enforcing laws aimed at addressing the threats highlighted by the IUCN's classification of species. Additionally, the policy is intended to support and stimulate research dedicated to endangered species. It applies to all individuals within the EU community, including students, staff, contracted service workers, vendors, and visitors.

EU is dedicated to advancing environmental sustainability, bolstering efforts to conserve biodiversity, and fostering active participation from its community in conservation-related endeavors. To this end, the university plans to increase awareness by hosting educational seminars and training sessions for its students, employees, and the broader public.

The Identification, Monitoring, and Conservation of IUCN and Other Species Policy is binding for all participants in EU-related activities, including students, staff, and contracted service providers. This policy reflects EU's commitment to protecting biodiversity and encouraging sustainable practices within its operational scope.
